Item Number 1: To confirm the proceedings of the last meeting and matters arising thereof.

Item Number 2: To take initiative for formation/activation of Alumni Association

Mr Amit Dasgupta said that for better co-ordination with people outside the college Alumni Association would be of immense help. He said that there was an Alumni Association when NAAC assessment was done in 2005. Now that alumni was almost defunct. We should try to revive that alumni or to form a formal alumni association.

Item Number 3: To make a plan for Transparent Admission

Dr Prasanta Sharma, TIC said that the admission process would start from the month of June after declaration of Plus two results of different boards. He added that there were few incidences in the past which raised questions about the transparency of admission. Mr. Amit Dasgupta said that as we were among the first few colleges in West Bengal to adopt partial online procedure in admission we should make further use of online method to make admission transparent and hassle free.

Item Number 4: Campus Placement

Dr. Nabanita Chakrabarti said that a number of companies had shown interest in recruiting our students. She requested Ms. Sharmistha Dasgupta, In-charge, Placement Cell to give details of campus placement. Ms. Dasgupta gave the details and explained her future plans
